Gymnasts victimized by Nassar will receive financial compensation for FBI failures.

The U.S. government will pay \$138.7 million in compensation to hundreds of victims of sexual abuse committed by Larry Nassar, a former doctor for the national gymnastics team who worked for over two decades at the University of Michigan and for the sport's federation.

Finally, the internal investigation concluded that there were errors in handling the complaints received against Nassar, which allowed the doctor to continue sexually assaulting more young individuals until he was arrested in 2016.
