The Vietnamese tycoon racing against time to raise \$9 billion to avoid her execution.

The Vietnamese real estate tycoon Truong My Lan has lost her appeal against the death sentence she received for orchestrating the world's largest banking fraud.

The 68-year-old woman is now fighting for her life, as Vietnamese law stipulates that if she can return 75% of what she took, her sentence could be commuted to life imprisonment.

In April, the court of first instance found that Truong My Lan had secretly controlled Saigon Commercial Bank (SCB), the country's fifth-largest lender, and had obtained loans and cash over more than a decade through a network of shell companies, amounting to a total of \$44 billion.
