## Key provisions of the new European legislation on artificial intelligence come into force.

The most emblematic measures focus on general-purpose AI systems, such as image or text generation models: OpenAI's ChatGPT, Google's Gemini, and xAI's Grok, owned by Elon Musk.

Developers will be required to provide authorities with technical documentation on the architecture of their programs and ensure transparency regarding the data used to train them. Furthermore, in terms of governance, the twenty-seven member states of the European Union (EU) will have to inform the European Commission about which national authorities will be responsible for overseeing compliance with the new rules. Service providers will, therefore, be subject to stricter monitoring.
