Just weeks after the FBI uncovered an illegal betting scandal in the NBA and rigged poker games, American sports were rocked by a new case, this time involving Dominican MLB pitchers Emmanuel Clase and Luis Ortiz, accused of participating in a rigged betting scheme.

According to investigations announced by the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of New York, Clase and Ortiz provided bettors with advance notice of the types of pitches they would throw and intentionally threw balls instead of strikes to ensure winning bets.
