

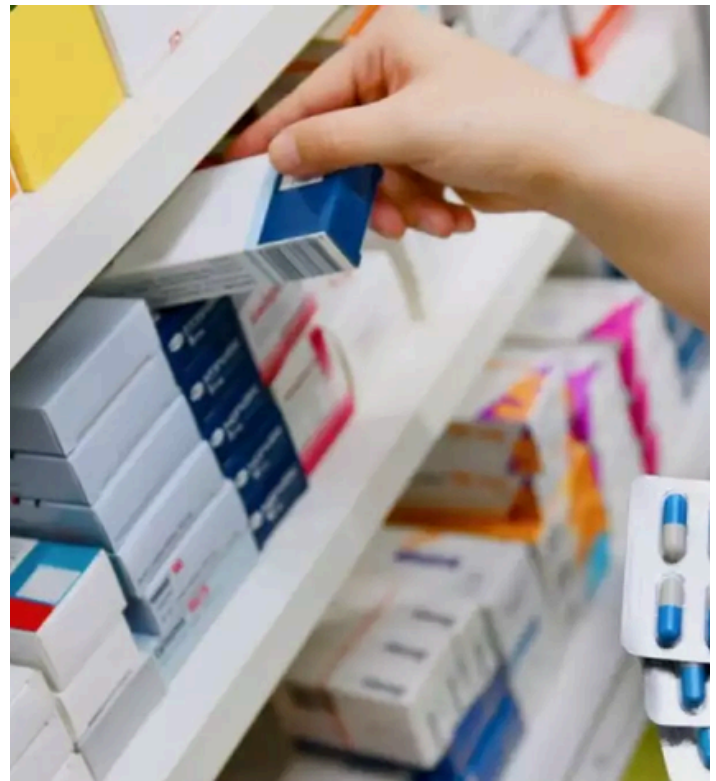

Mexican Government awarded contracts worth 3.792 billion pesos to sanctioned companies, IMCO reveals.

Companies that committed irregularities in public procurement processes are still being hired by the government. In 2025, public institutions awarded contracts worth 3.792 billion pesos to suppliers that are sanctioned by the Ministry of Anti-Corruption and Good Governance.

They also awarded contracts to companies that had been created just one year earlier, which together amounted to 808 million pesos, according to an analysis by the Mexican Institute for Competitiveness (IMCO).
